### Appointment to the College of Canons of Hereford Cathedral

Late last year, Bishop Richard appointed Christobel Hargraves as Prebendary de Wellington. She will be licensed and collated on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> May at 3.30pm during Evensong at Hereford Cathedral. You are warmly invited to be part of this service.

This appointment is in recognition of her service to the Diocese and she will not be leaving Stretton Parish!!

What is a Prebendary? The prebendal stalls (seat) in the Cathedral are named after parcels of land (often local farms) which were known as "prebends" and which gave each stallholder an income: although the income has long since gone, the title remains! The use of the title prebendary was an indication of membership of the greater chapter of so-called Old Foundation Cathedrals (the 9 pre-reformation non-monastic cathedrals). Their sister cathedrals (former monastic foundations and those founded by Henry VIII) always called members of their greater chapters honorary canons. In practice therefore the two titles—Prebendary and Canon—have little difference.
