As background, my first career was in destination marketing in the 80s and 90s,



Alpha


Are you interested in attending Alpha? Or do you know someone who you think might be? It would be helpful if you book in by **17th September**, so we can plan the catering.

There are eight sessions, to be held weekly on Wednesday evenings at 7.30pm in the Parish Centre, beginning on 1st October.


